EXTENSION OF TIME FOR WRITTEN SUBMISSIONS ON THE DRAFT NUMBERING PLAN REGULATIONS

- The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa (herein referred to as "the Authority") released the Draft Numbering Regulations in Government Gazette No. 33269 of the 04th June 2010.
- These draft regulations invited interested parties to submit written submissions to the Authority by the 19th July 2010.
- The Authority has received a number of requests for an extension of time for written submissions to these draft regulations.
- 4. The deadline for written submissions has been extended to the 26th July 2010 by no later than 16h30.
- 5. Persons interested in participating in public hearings must indicate such interest in their written submission.
