NOTICE TO EXEMPT THE PENSION FUND INDUSTRY, THE COLLECTIVE INVESTMENT SCHEMES INDUSTRY AND THE SECURITY SERVICES INDUSTRY FROM THE CONSUMER PROTECTION ACT, 2008 (No.68 of 2008)
