GENERAL NOTICE -THE EXTENSION OF CARRIER PRE-SELECTION (CPS) REGULATIONS, GG 33589 (CPS PHASE 1) IMPLEMENTATION TIMELINES AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF CPS CODE OF CONDUCT.
