REGISTRATION FOR A CLASS COMMUNITY SATELLITE TELEVISION BROADCASTING SERVICE LICENCE BY MZANSI COMMUNITY SATELLITE TELEVISION

- 1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") in terms of regulation 14 of the Class Licensing Processes and Procedures Regulations (as amended), 2010 hereby gives notice that it has received an application for registration of a class licence to provide a community satellite television broadcasting service lodged by Mzansi Community Satellite TV ("Mzansi TV"). The application for registration is lodged in terms of section 16(2) and 17(1) of the Electronic Communications Act 36 of 2005, read with regulation 7(2) of the Class Licensing Processes and Procedures Regulations.
- The application, relevant schedule and any representations received pursuant thereto will be made available and be open for inspection by interested parties in the Authority's library during the Authority's normal office hours.

Interested parties must indicate in their written representations if they would like to be afforded an opportunity to make an oral presentation during the public hearings on this matter.

Mzansi TV shall be entitled to respond in writing to written representations made by interested persons on the application for the registration, and such written response must be lodged with the Authority within forty (40) working days of the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette. Mzansi TV must, at the time of lodging such written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of such response by hand, or has sent a copy of such response by registered mail or by facsimile to the relevant person having made such written representations.
