Regarding the inclusion of special votes in the electoral timetable as set out below-

Application for special vote

- 8 10(1) By not later than 30 May 2012 a voter may apply in terms of Regulation 28B (1) to cast special vote within the voting district where she or he is registered. [Applications for special votes will only be received from 21 May 2012]
 - (2) On 12 June 2012 voters who had successfully applied to cast their special votes at the voting station, may visit the voting station between 08h00 and 17h00 to cast their special votes.
 - (3) On 12 June 2012 voting officers must visit voters who had successfully applied to cast their special votes at their places of residence, to afford them the opportunity to cast their votes there.
