NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE THE SOUTH AFRICAN MARITIME AND AERONAUTICAL SEARCH AND RESCUE AMENDMENT BILL, 2012 INTO PARLIAMENT (RULE 241(1) (b) OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY)

The Minister of Transport hereby in terms of National Assembly Rule No.241(1) (b) intends introducing the South African Maritime and Aeronautical Search and Rescue Amendment Bill, 2012("the Bill") in Parliament during the third term of 2012. The Bill and its Explanatory Memorandum was published for comments in Government Gazette No. 33126 of 23rd April 2010, Notice 338 of 2010 and is called the South African Maritime and Search and Rescue Amendment Bill, 2012

The object of the Bill is as follows:

- **To amend the South African Maritime and Aeronautical Search and Rescue Act, 2002, so as to insert a definition; to expand the composition of the South African Search and Rescue Organisation (SASAR); to provide for the management committee and the sub-committees of SASAR; to provide for SASAR to perform its function outside the Republic's search and rescue regions in accordance with the Conventions; to effect certain textual corrections; to delete obsolete provisions; to compel all licence holders of aerodromes, airfields, heliports or helistops to file emergency plans with the**

aeronautical rescue co-ordination centre; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

Interested persons and institutions should forward their submissions on the draft Bill to the Secretary of Parliament on or before the 31st August 2012. Copies of the Bill can be obtained from;
