AN EXTENSION TO THE CLOSING DATE

PURSUANT TO SECTION 8 (1) AND (2), OF THE RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM FEE REGULATIONS, NOTICE NO.33495 OF 27 AUGUST 2010 AND THE RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM REGULATIONS PART IV, 9 (1)-(4)

HEREBY ISSUES A NOTICE AND INVITES LICENSEES TO NOTIFY THE AUTHORITY OF ITS INTENTION TO RENEW THEIR RADIO FREQUENCY LICENCES AND OR TO APPLY FOR A MULTI-YEAR LICENCE FOR AMATEUR, AERONAUTICAL AND SHIP STATION CATEGORIES.

1. The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice and invites:
 - Applications **FOR INTENTION TO RENEW** radio frequency spectrum licences as stipulated under Part IV Sections 9 (1) to (4) of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulation notice no 34172 issued on 31 March 2011.
 - Applications for **A MULTI-YEAR LICENCE** for Amateur, Aeronautical and Ship station categories stipulated under Section 8 (1) to (2) of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Fee Regulations, notice no 33495 issued on 27 August 2010.

Draft Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulation

2. Electronic copies of the Radio Frequency Spectrum Regulations and the Radio Frequency Spectrum Fee Regulations are available on the Authority's website (www.icasa.org.za).
3. Licensees under the categories mentioned in paragraph 1 above are encouraged to apply for multi-year licences to qualify for the discount in radio frequency spectrum fees payable.
4. Licences for which no intention to renew is submitted will be regarded as **EXPIRED AND INVALID** at the end of the current financial year.
5. Licensees who have changed their contact details such as address and other means of contact are reminded to inform the Authority within fourteen (14) days of the change in terms Part VII, section 31(1) of the Radio Regulation notice no 34172 issued on 31 March 2011 by completing the attached template thereto and send by e-mail or post to the addresses mentioned under paragraph 6 below on or before 01 February 2013.


