THE SOUTH AFRICAN SCHOOLS ACT, 1996 (ACT NO. 84 OF 1996)

AN EXTENSION OF THE VALIDITY PERIOD OF THE SCHOOL-BASED ASSESSMENT REQUIREMENT OF THE 2008-2013 COHORTS OF NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE CANDIDATES WHO WERE UNSUCCESSFUL IN OBTAINING A NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE POST THE EXPIRY DATE

1. I, Angelina Matsie Motshekga, Minister of Basic Education, in terms of regulation 7(5) of the Regulations pertaining to the conduct, administration and management of the National Senior Certificate examination, promulgated in Government Gazette No. 37651 of 16 May 2014, hereby extend the validity period of the School-Based Assessment requirement of the National Senior Certificate candidates, where the validity period has expired, by an additional year. This extension will apply until an alternative qualification, which grants these candidates a concession for School-Based Assessment, is in place.
