These fossils have achieved international acclaim by scientists for their superb preservation, abundance and richness in diversity to the extent that this locality is now widely regarded as possibly the most important Early Pliocene terrestrial fossil occurrence in the world.


- Six (6) months after the publication of this notice for audio, video and related equipment.
- Products that are already in the market and approved by the NRCS for safety requirements are to comply with this compulsory specification twelve (12) months after the publication of this notice.

Phase 2:

- Nine (9) months after the publication of this notice for electric ovens, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, tumble dryers, washer-dryer combinations and washing machines.
- Products that are already in the market and approved by the NRCS for safety requirements are to comply with this compulsory specification twelve (12) months after the publication of this notice.

Phase 3:

- Eighteen (18) months after the publication of this notice for air conditioners and heat pumps.

SCHEDULE

COMPULSORY SPECIFICATION FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY AND LABELING OF ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC APPARATUS (VC 9008)

1. SCOPE

1.1 This compulsory specification covers energy efficiency requirements and energy efficiency labeling of the following electrical and electronic apparatus:

- a) air conditioners not exceeding 7.1 kW (24 000 btu/h) cooling capacity, of the wall mounted split, window and portable types, and heat pumps for space heating and cooling;
- b) audio and video equipment, including television sets, video recording equipment, simple set top boxes (SSTBs), audio equipment and multi-function equipment for consumer use; television sets include, but are not limited to, those with cathode ray tube (CRT), liquid crystal display (LCD), plasma display panel (PDP), or projection technologies;
- c) dishwashers;
- d) electric ovens;
- e) refrigerators and freezers;
- f) tumble dryers;
- g) washer-dryer combinations; and
- h) washing machines.

2. DEFINITIONS

- 2.1 For the purposes of this document, the definitions in SANS 50229, SANS 50242, SANS 50285, SANS 50304, SANS 54511-3, SANS 60081, SANS 60456, SANS 61121, SANS 62087, SANS 62301 and SANS 62552 apply.
- 2.2 In addition, the following definitions shall apply:
- 2.2.1 **applicant:** The manufacturer or importer seeking approval of Electrical and Electronic apparatus. The applicant shall be an existing legal entity within the Republic of South Africa.
- 2.2.2 **approval:** Confirmation by the NRCS that a particular electrical/electronic apparatus type satisfies the requirements of this compulsory specification.
- 2.2.3 **conformity of production:** Proof that electrical/electronic apparatus offered for sale have been manufactured to the approved design and continue to comply with the requirements of this compulsory specification.
- 2.2.4 **declaration report:** A report that is issued by an accredited conformity assessment body, indicating the equivalence of products and/or standards.
- 2.2.5 **NRCS:** The National Regulator for Compulsory Specifications as established by the National Regulator for Compulsory Specifications Act, 2008 (Act No. 5 of 2008).
- 2.2.6 **proof of conformity:** Documented evidence of conformity with the requirements of this compulsory specification.
- 2.2.7 **valid test report:** An original certificate or a certified copy of an original test report.
- 2.2.8 **valid certificate of conformity:** An original certificate or a certified copy of an original certificate of conformity.
- 2.2.9 **small electrical oven:** Is an electrical oven with a volume = 12 L (litres) and volume < 35 L (litres).
- 2.2.10 **medium electrical volume:** Is an electrical oven with a volume = 35 L and volume < 65 L (litres);
- 2.2.11 **large electrical oven:** is an oven with a volume =65 L (litres).

3. GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1** The applicant shall ensure that each type of apparatus has been approved by the NRCS before offering it for sale, in accordance with the requirements of Annex A.
- 3.2** The applicant shall inform the NRCS of any change in design or materials affecting any mandatory requirement in terms of this compulsory specification. In the event of such change(s) the NRCS may, at its discretion, demand that the applicant submit a new application for approval.
- 3.3** The applicant shall, on request, provide the NRCS, within five (5) working days, with satisfactory proof of approval in respect of any type of Electrical/Electronic apparatus included in the scope of this compulsory specification.
- 3.4** The applicant shall on request provide the NRCS, within five (5) working days, with satisfactory proof of conformity of production.
- 3.5** Failure to provide such proof shall constitute reasonable grounds for suspicion of non-compliance with the requirements of this compulsory specification.

4. SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS

4.1 Air Conditioners and Heat Pumps

Air conditioners shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class B.

4.2 Audio and Video Equipment

Audio and Video Equipment shall comply with SANS 941.

4.3 Large Electric Ovens

Large Electric Ovens shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class B.

4.4 Small/ Medium Electric Ovens

Electric Ovens shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class A.

4.5 Refrigerators

Refrigerators shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class B.

4.6 Freezers

Freezers shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class C.

4.7 Dishwashers

Dishwashers shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class A.

4.8 Washing Machines

Washing Machines shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class A.

4.9 Washer-dryer combinations

Washer-dryer combination machines shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class A.

4.10 Tumble -dryers

Tumble-dryers shall comply with SANS 941, and shall have a minimum energy efficiency rating of Class D.

5. EQUIVALENCE OF STANDARDS

Standards issued by different standardization bodies such as ISO, IEC and EN, will only be accepted if it is proven, in the form of a declaration report from an accredited conformity assessment body, that they are technically equivalent to the relevant South African National Standard. The applicant shall be responsible for obtaining such a declaration report. Proof of conformity with such a standard shall be accepted as conformity with the corresponding South African National Standard.

6. CONFORMITY TO REFERENCED STANDARDS

- 6.1 For the purposes of this compulsory specification, a new edition of a referenced standard shall become effective twelve (12) months from the date of publication as a South African National Standard.
- 6.2 New products, or products resubmitted for approval because of a change in design or materials, shall in all cases be evaluated against the requirements of the latest edition of any referenced standard.

The Minister of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries received a request from the South African Mango Growers' Association (SAMGA) for the implementation of statutory measures (registration, records & returns and levies) for a new four (4) year period, on fresh mangoes intended for the processing market, that includes achar, juice, dried mangoes and mangoes for fruit salads, in terms of the Marketing of Agricultural Products Act (MAP Act), Act No. 47 of 1996.

If approved, processors of mango fruit (drying, achar, juice and any other activity where the skin of the fruit is broken) will be responsible for collecting of the levy (R33/ton), from the producers, on behalf of SAMGA.

The statutory levy will finance the following:

- Collection, processing and dissemination of reliable processing and market information;
- Processing, product and market research;
- Technology transfer;
- Stimulation of consumption of processed mango;
- Determination of quality standards;
- Promotion of co-operation between growers, processors and other industry role players;
- Promotion of market access including gaining, retaining and optimising markets;
- Facilitation of transformation within the industry; and
- Benchmarking and determination of best practice.

The proposed statutory measures will be applicable for a four year period, effective from date of implementation. The previous statutory measures expired on 29 October 2014.

The NAMC believes that the proposed statutory measures requested are consistent with the objectives of the MAP Act (as set out in section 2 of the Act).

Directly affected groups (e.g. producers, exporters and export inspection bodies) in the mango industry are kindly requested to submit any comments, in writing, regarding the proposed statutory measures, to the NAMC on or before 17 January 2015, to enable the Council to finalise its recommendation to the Minister in this regard.



BOARD NOTICE 140 OF 2014

NATIONAL COUNCIL OF SOCIETIES FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO ANIMALS

RULES

1 NEW RULE TO BE NUMBERED 5.6

DISCIPLINARY HEARINGS

- 1 A society shall conduct a disciplinary hearing in accordance with the provisions of this rule, but otherwise in accordance with the labour laws in operation from time to time.
- 2 Members of the management committee shall not prosecute the charges brought against an employee in a disciplinary hearing nor shall any member of the committee preside at or be a member of the disciplinary panel receiving the evidence at such inquiry.
- 3 The members of the disciplinary panel and the prosecutor shall be independent persons, and the chairperson shall be a qualified legal practitioner or person who has knowledge of labour relations.
- 4 The disciplinary panel shall make a finding on each charge and determine, where appropriate, the disciplinary action, if any, that should be taken against the employee.
- 5 The findings and decisions of the disciplinary panel shall be reported to the management committee at its next meeting for recording.
- 6 Where the employee has been sanctioned, and enjoys a right of appeal against such sanction, unless the contract of employment provides otherwise, the appeal shall be determined by the management committee after due consideration of the record of the disciplinary hearing and any further representations made to it by the employee and/or management.

2 NEW RULE TO BE NUMBERED 5.7

When a motion has been defeated at a general meeting of members, the same or a substantially similar motion may not be proposed for consideration prior to the expiry of 24 months from the date of the meeting upon which the motion was defeated.

3 AMMENDMENT TO RULE 6.18

- (a) All severely injured or compromised indigenous wildlife admitted to an SPCA that is in such condition that it would be cruel to keep it alive, must be humanely euthanased by an experienced, skilled and qualified person.
- (b) All stray, surrendered, confiscated, sick or injured indigenous wildlife admitted to an SPCA must be transferred to a rehabilitation and release centre approved by the NSPCA to handle the species.
- (c) If no approved rehabilitation and release centre is within reasonable distance, alternative arrangements cannot be made to transport the animal to another approved rehabilitation and release centre or there is no approved rehabilitation and release centre able to rehabilitate and release the animal, the animal must be euthanased.
- (d) A Society shall not take it upon themselves to release indigenous wildlife. This can only be done with specialist knowledge and in accordance with Nature Conservation laws and regulations.
- (e) A Society shall not hold any indigenous wildlife for a period exceeding 5 days.

4 AMENDMENT TO RULE 6.10

A Society shall not home an animal, if it knows or ought to know that the animal will or might reasonably be expected to be kept chained or caged, or permanently housed in an enclosure, not relative to the size or specific needs of the species with regards to its natural habits and safety. This Rule must be read in conjunction with Rule 6.21.

5 AMMENDMENT TO RULE 2.14

A Whenever it becomes apparent to the Board that the management committee of a Society has ceased to function (henceforth referred to as "**the Society in question**") and the Board is of the opinion that the Society cannot function adequately until a new management committee can be elected by the members of the Society in due course and in terms of that Society's constitution, then –

A.1 the Board may by notice appoint an interim committee ("**the interim committee**") comprised of the same number of members required in terms of the Society in question's constitution and which shall consist of persons selected by the Board from–

- (i) that Society; and/or
- (ii) members of the Board; and/or
- (iii) members of any other Society; and/or
- (iv) members of staff of the NSPCA and/or of any other Society;

A.2 the interim committee so appointed shall have all such powers and duties as are granted to the management committee of the Society in question under that Society's constitution to its management committee;

A.3 the Board shall fix the term of office of the Interim Committee.

B Whenever the Board exercises the powers referred to in sub-rule (1), it must report the fact and the circumstances to the next ensuing general meeting of the NSPCA.

C Any member of a Society that is aggrieved by a decision of the Board to appoint an interim committee shall notify the Board in writing of his or her dissatisfaction and the reasons therefore. In the event that the Board fails to address the member's grievances to the members satisfaction within 15 days of receipt of that member's written notice, then the member's grievances shall be referred to arbitration to be conducted under the aegis of the Arbitration Foundation of Southern Africa ("AFSA") and in terms of AFSA's Expedited Rules of Arbitration.

6 NEW GUIDELINE TO BE NUMBERED 14

In terms of the new Rule regarding disciplinary proceedings against employees, the management committee of a Society is required to hear any appeal noted by an employee against the decision of the disciplinary panel. The following members of the committee must recuse themselves from the committee's deliberations:

- (a) Those who may have given evidence or had evidence to give, whether or not the evidence was given
- (b) Those who have a special relationship with the employee for any reason
- (c) Those who have previously expressed support or criticism of the employee

Recuse means declaring the reason and leaving the meeting while the appeal is debated and voted upon. Recused members may rejoin the meeting for the announcement of the meeting.
