- section 266(1) and (2) of the Financial Services Laws General Amendment Act, 2013 (Act No. 45 of 2013) ("the FSLGA Act") hereby determine 1 April 2017 as the date on which section 264 of the FSLGA Act, insofar as it amends in the Schedule to the FSLGA Act, section 1 of the Medical Schemes Act, 1998 (Act No. 131 of 1998), takes effect.
- section 57(1) and (2) of the Insurance Laws Amendment Act 2008 (Act No. 27 of 2008) ("the ILA Act") hereby determine 1 April 2017 as the date on which sections 1(f) and 27(a) of the ILA Act take effect.
