Presorted bulk mail

- The service is suitable for businesses that post large numbers of domestic letters. The minimum volume is 1 000 and more presorted articles per consignment.
- The items must meet the relevant criteria as described in the National Bulk Mail Service Guide.
- All articles in a consignment must -
 - originate from the same sender,
 - be identical in shape, size and mass; and
 - have the same contents.
- The articles must contain return addresses.

- Mail will only be accepted if the official payment methods are used, i.e. stamps, Permit Mail (only presorted bulk mail), remote meter-setting franking machine mail, postage-paid and postage-included envelopes.
- No rebates apply to letters with stamps as a payment method.
- The client must have his database checked by an official PAMSS and provide the official grading certificate with each posting together with the Bulk Mail Delivery Note.
- Mail must be posted at designated mail centres and mail accepting offices only.

Items larger than 353 x 250 mm, thicker than 30 mm and weighing more than 1 kg will be considered parcels.

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What is considered as a parcel?

Any postal item larger than 250 x 353 mm and/or thicker than 30 mm and/or weighing more than 1 kg will be considered a parcel.

- Fees are based on the greater of the actual mass or the volumetric mass (i.e. Length by width by height (cm) divided by 5000) are charged for non-documents (parcels)

Insurance is an optional extra. The client has the option of insuring the ordinary parcel at a rate of three per cent of the declared value up to a maximum of R5 000 with a minimum rate of R 4.20 per parcel.

1.4 International mail

International letter and parcel services are available worldwide, either by airmail or surface mail. These services may be accessed by posting either at post offices or by posting in street posting boxes. The available range of services includes:

Special value-added services

Value can be added to basic international mail services by buying additional value-added services. These include express delivery, registered, insured and advice-of-delivery (AR) options. As these add-on services are not available to some countries or for some categories of mail, enquiries should be made at post offices to find out if they are available for your purposes. Insured and registered items must be posted at post office counters and not in street post-boxes.

International reply coupons

The international reply coupon service enables customers to repay the postage on a reply from a correspondent abroad. Coupons sent abroad may be exchanged for one or more postage stamps representing the minimum postage pre-payable on an air-mail letter. The coupons cost R 33.05 and are available at post offices.

Exchange control regulations

Exchange control regulations apply equally to postal items as they do to other exports. Generally, items of a value of more than R1 000 require specific export documents to be completed. Details are available at post offices.

Customs declarations

The type and extent of customs declarations are regulated by the statutes of the Universal Postal Union and the requirements of destination countries. The following basic requirements are stipulated for the various mail categories.

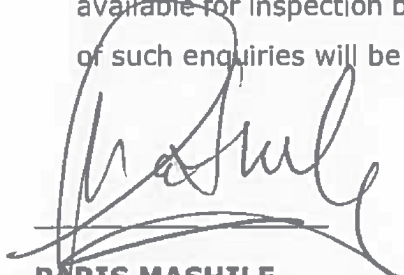

20. The Authority will open the applications after the closing time and affix on each container the time of receipt and will provide each applicant with an acknowledgement.

21. Applications submitted after 16h00 on the Application Date will not be considered by the Authority. An application received after the closing date and time will neither be accepted nor considered by the Authority.

22. Failure to comply with the requirements set out in this ITA will render the application liable for disqualification.

23. The Radio Frequency Spectrum licence for MUX 3 frequencies must be awarded using a competitive process. The following three (3) stages will be followed:

Phase 1 - Prequalification criteria;

Phase 2 - Sealed Bids; and

26. An applicant that fails to comply with any of the requirements of paragraph 25 will be disqualified.

27. An applicant that has complied with all the requirements of paragraph 25 will qualify to participate in the next phase, which is the Sealed Bids. The Authority will inform the applicants to submit sealed/closed bids. The successful applicant will be the highest bidder.

28. MUX 3 broadcasting frequencies will be assigned to the successful applicant.

29. The successful applicant will be assigned 45 % of MUX 3 capacity by the Authority for commercial subscription television broadcasting services. The available channels for MUX 3 capacity excludes engineering channels reserved for the use of technical information.

30. An applicant must commit not to engage in any activity, which would or could be construed as grounds for disqualification as indicated in Schedule F.

31. Prior to the awarding of the spectrum licence, the applicant will be required to provide proof of funding to support the proposed launch date.

32. The Authority reserves its right not to grant a licence should an Applicant not meet the requirements as set out in this ITA.

33. In addition to the terms and conditions set out in this section, Applicants are advised to apprise themselves fully of the provisions of the ECA, ICASA Act, all regulations promulgated by the Authority that may be applicable to this ITA.

34. All applicants shall carry their own costs in responding to the ITA.

3.1	This licence shall be valid from the date of issue and shall run parallel to and not exceed the duration of a service licence contemplated in Chapter 3 of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act No. 36 of 2005).
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4. SPECTRUM LICENCE FEES

4.1	The licensee must pay radio frequency spectrum licence fee as prescribed from time to time.
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5. RIGHT TO USE MUX 3 RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM

5.1	The licensee is authorized to use the radio frequency spectrum in accordance with the technical parameters and locations as set out in Annexure G of the Terrestrial Broadcasting Frequency Plan that forms part of this licence.
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6. WITHDRAWAL OF RADIO SPECTRUM LICENCE

6.1	Failure to meet the targets set out in the roll-out obligation as in 7.4 below prior to second anniversary of the first proposed launch of the service is considered non-utilization and a breach of the terms and conditions of the radio frequency spectrum licence; and this will result in the radio frequency spectrum licence withdrawal as outlined section 31(8) to (10) of the Act.
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6.2	The Authority may withdraw a radio frequency spectrum licence under the following circumstances: (a) Whereby the licensee is placed in liquidation; (b) Whereby the licensee's service licence has been revoked by the Authority or cancelled by the licensee; (c) Whereby the licensee has repeatedly breached the terms and conditions of a radio frequency spectrum licence or the provisions of the Regulations; (d) Upon failure to use the assigned radio frequencies within two (2) years of the granting of the radio frequency spectrum licence; or (e) Upon the need for use of the frequency spectrum during an emergency including both man-made and natural disasters.
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7. RADIO COVERAGE ROLL-OUT OBLIGATIONS

7.1	A licensee must ensure that the appointed signal distributor use the MUX 3 broadcasting radio frequency spectrum frequencies for the construction and operation of Digital Terrestrial Television Distribution Network for the provisioning of commercial television broadcasting services.
7.2	A licensee must ensure that the appointed signal distributor distributes 45% of MUX3 capacity that is assigned by the Authority pursuant to the issue of this spectrum licence.
7.3	A licensee must ensure that the appointed signal distributor for 45% of MUX 3 capacity, through a commercial arrangement and without prejudice, distributes 55% of MUX3 capacity that would be assigned by the Authority pursuant to finalization of a process to license additional commercial Free-to-Air (FTA) television broadcasting services licences.
7.4	Fifty percent (50%) of the licensed 45% of MUX 3 Digital Terrestrial Television Distribution network must be completed prior to second anniversary of the first proposed launch of the service.
7.5	The Authority will review the radio frequency spectrum utilization by the licensee two (2) years after launch of the service.

7.6	A licensee must submit to the Authority, prior to the second anniversary of the launch of the service, a declaration: a) Stating that the broadcasting services are being provided; b) Detailing the extent of the network roll out; and c) Outlining the timelines for completion of the distribution network.
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8. GENERAL CONDITIONS

8.1	The licensee must, at all times, observe the provisions of international telecommunications conventions, such as those prescribed by the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) Radio Regulations and as they apply to the Republic of South Africa.
8.2	The licensee indemnifies ICASA against any claims for damages or loss that may occur as a result of the switching off, of the transmitters as stipulated in Schedule H or, as a result of any interruptions to the service that may affect the quality of signals.
8.3	The licensee indemnifies ICASA against any claims for damages or loss that may result from interference to or interruption of the transmitters caused by radio users and electronic communication lines lawfully operated in terms of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act No. 36 of 2005) and applicable regulations.

9. LAUNCH DATE

The licensee must use the assigned radio frequencies within two (2) years of the granting of the radio frequency spectrum licence. However, the licensee must inform the Authority on the actual date of launch.

SCHEDULE C – AMENDMENTS TO THE APPLICATION

1. In instances where the information included in an application changes at any time after submission of the application but before the Authority makes a decision, the applicant must notify the Authority of such changes and request an amendment to its application in writing within seven (7) days of such change.

SCHEDULE 1 –THE RULES FOR SEALED BIDS AUCTION FOR RADIO FREQUENCY SPECTRUM LICENCE FOR 45% OF MULTIPLEX 3 (MUX) CAPACITY

1. Introduction

The competitive selection procedure that will be used by the Authority to assign the usage rights to frequencies designated as Multiplex 3 in the Terrestrial Broadcasting Frequency Plan 2013 will be referred to as a **MUX3 Auction**. The spectrum licence will be assigned for use of terrestrial digital television service within the borders of South Africa. The spectrum licence will be valid from the date of issue and shall run parallel to and not exceed the duration of the service licence, subject to compliance with applicable regulations.

This document establishes the rules, procedures as well as the terms and conditions governing the MUX3 Auction and post auction application and payment processes.

2. Submissions of Bids

Only bidders that have received a letter confirming that they met the qualification criteria following Phase 1 of the process, are allowed to submit sealed bids as part of the auction. Sealed bids shall be deposited, in person, in a marked box at the reception of ICASA offices in Block A, 164 Katherine Street, Pinmill Farm, Sandton. Each qualifying applicant shall submit only one sealed bid, in the form of a certified check, letter of credit or bank guarantee from a banking institution. The applicants are required to send at least one representative, but not more than three (3), to attend the MUX 3 Auction.

The minimum bid amount prescribed for the MUX3 Auction is set at R100 000.00 (one hundred thousand Rand Only). The bid amount should be in South African Rand and clearly visible, written in both the numerical and worded value.

Bidders shall submit a copy of the front page of their Broadcasting Service Licence together with the bid amount in a sealed brown A4 envelope. There shall be no information or printing which may identify the Bidder on the envelope. On submission, the applicant will be provided with a receipt as a proof of submission.

Bidders shall also submit a declaration of their proposed launch of the service.

2.1 Submission deadline

The deadline for the submission of bids is Monday 19 November 2018, 16h00 South African Time. The time indicated on the clock in the reception hall of Block A will be regarded as the correct time. After the expiry of the closing date, no bids will be allowed by the Authority under any circumstances. The submission box will remain unopened at the Reception area of Block A until the official opening of bids.

2.2 Announcement of results

Immediately after the closing time, representatives of applicants will be invited to the Spectrum Licensing boardroom, in Block A. The sealed envelopes will be opened. The winner of the MUX3 Auction will be determined based on the highest bid amount received.

3. Bid Disqualification

Applicants are cautioned to carefully examine their bids because once the sealed bid has been submitted in the box, it cannot be removed or altered. Bidders are responsible for ensuring that their bids are complete and in accordance with requirements. All bids that did not follow the bid rules will be immediately disqualified.

3.1 Submission of more than one bid

Bidders shall submit only one sealed envelope, bidders that submit more than one sealed bid will be immediately disqualified.

3.2 Late Submissions

FEE GUIDELINE AND SCHEDULES PURSUANT TO THE GUIDELINE IN TERMS OF REGULATION 19(13) OF THE NATIONAL CREDIT ACT, 34 OF 2005, AS AMENDED

This Fee Guideline is issued pursuant to the Guideline issued by the National Credit Regulator in terms of Regulation 19 (13) on 3rd November 2017 ("the 19(13) Guideline") and is applicable to all credit providers, all credit bureaux and data providers as defined in the Guideline.

PURPOSE OF THIS GUIDELINE: This Fee Guideline prescribes the fees payable to SACRRA for: i) the onboarding of credit and data providers, ii) the maintenance and use of the Data Transmission Hub, and iii) the monitoring and reporting of all data submitted via the Data Transmission Hub to the credit bureaux.

1. Definitions pursuant to this Fee Guideline

[Unless otherwise herein defined, definitions of terms are as set out in the 19(13) Guideline].

"Maintenance fees" means the fees payable annually for the usage and maintenance of the Data Transmission Hub, data format and reporting to the NCR in terms thereof.

Any reference to hours or days in this Fee Guideline shall mean hours in a business day, or business days, respectively.

2. Onboarding fees

2.1 Onboarding fees do not apply to any SACRRA member or any other person who is currently submitting data to the credit bureaux via the Data Transmission Hub.

2.2 The onboarding fees for credit providers in categories 1-5 and data providers are set out in Schedule 1 hereto;

2.3 The onboarding fees for Categories 6-9 will be prescribed in December 2018 by way of Schedule 2 hereto.

3. Onboarding process

3.1 All credit providers in Categories 1 - 5 and all data providers who have completed the initial assessment process and have paid the corresponding assessment fees, must commence the onboarding process with the SACRRA with effect from 15th January 2018.

3.2 The onboarding of credit providers in Categories 1-5 and all data providers must be complete by no later than 30th November 2018.

3.3 Any credit provider in Category 1-5 and any data provider who has completed the onboarding process prior to 2019, may commence with submission of credit information to the credit bureaux prior to the finalisation of the fee structure for the maintenance and use of the Data Transmission Hub and the layout, subject to:

3.3.1 Due approval by the SACRRA; and

3.3.2 Payment of maintenance and usage fees for the Data Transmission Hub, the layout and reporting to the NCR, in an amount equal to the pro-rata fees payable by SACRRA members for 2018 with effect from the date of commencement of submission of data.

3.4 Any credit provider, data provider or credit bureau who provides or receives credit information via the Data Transmission Hub and who is not a member of SACRRA and/or the Credit Bureau Association respectively, will pay a fee equivalent to the respective SACRRA and Credit Bureau Association fees applicable in 2018 to obtain access to the Data Transmission Hub, the data format, maintenance and amendment thereto, and any required reporting to the National Credit Regulator in terms of the 19 (13) Guideline.

4. Maintenance Fees payable

4.1 Maintenance fees are mandatory for all credit and data providers who provide credit information to credit bureaux via the Data Transmission Hub, and for all credit bureaux who receive credit information via the Data Transmission Hub.

4.2 Maintenance fees will be payable by all credit providers, data providers and credit bureaux to the SACRRA with effect from 15th January 2019 in accordance with the applicable fee categories.

4.3 The maintenance fees payable will be published by way of Schedule 2 hereto, on or before 15th December 2018.

5. Restrictions and Penalties

5.1 Assessment and Onboarding Fees and Process

5.1.1 All credit providers in Category 1-5 will be restricted to accessing credit bureau information via an online mechanism only, until such time as they have paid the assessment and onboarding fees and have completed the onboarding process.

5.1.2 The NCR may take enforcement action against any credit provider who fails to commence the onboarding process by 30th June 2019.

5.1.3 Provided that a data provider has paid the applicable assessment and onboarding fee, the data provider will have conditional online access to payment profile information for a period of three months, subject to the due completion of the onboarding process within the 3 month period.

5.1.4 No data provider will have access to any information via batch until such time as they commence with submission of their book of credit information, as approved during the onboarding process.

5.1.5 The SACRRA will provide a list to the credit bureaux and NCR on a monthly basis to enable them to monitor the access to credit bureau records as set out in 5.1.1 – 5.1.4, by providing:

- a) A list detailing all credit and data providers who have paid their assessment fees and commenced the onboarding process;
- b) A list detailing all credit and data providers who have been successfully onboarded by the SACRRA, indicating the applicable onboarding date;
- c) A list of all credit and data providers who have commenced submission of credit information to the credit bureaux in any given month
- d) A list of all credit and data providers who are subject to the restrictions set out in 5.1.1, 5.1.3 and 5.1.4.

5.2 Maintenance Fees

5.2.1 Any credit or data provider or credit bureaux who fails to pay its annual maintenance fee within 30 days will be subject to suspension of their access to the Data Transmission Hub for a period of 30 days. If the annual maintenance fees have not been paid before the expiry of 60 days, their access will be revoked;

5.2.2 Any credit provider or credit bureaux who fails to pay its maintenance fees before the expiry of the 60-day period set out in 5.2.1 above, will be reported to the NCR for immediate enforcement action.

6. **Effective date**

This Guideline is effective immediately in accordance with the timeframe set out herein.
