ELECTORAL COMMISSION**NOTICE 41 OF 2019****ELECTORAL COMMISSION****INVITATION TO MAKE REPRESENTATIONS**

The formula for determining the one half of members of the National Assembly is prescribed in terms of item (2)(a) of Schedule 1A of the Electoral Act, Act 73 of 1998.

The chief electoral officer hereby invites representations from interested parties and members of the public in respect of the proposed formula for the distribution of the regional seats to the National Assembly as follows:-

$$\text{Quota} = \text{TRUNC} ((A/(B + 1)) + 1)$$

Where

A = Total Registered Population excluding out of country registrations (26 727 921)

B = Number of regional seats, being 200

And where TRUNC returns an integer number disregarding fractions.

The quota is then divided into the registered population for each province. The first allocation is represented by the integer numbers disregarding fractions. Of the remaining seats after the first allocation, the second allocation is determined in order of the highest remainder (or fraction/s).

The final allocation for a region is the total of the first allocation, and where applicable the second allocation.
