CANCELLATION OF REGISTRATION OF A TRADE UNION

I, Mary Mongwadi Ngwetjana, Deputy Registrar of Labour Relations, hereby, in terms of section 109(2) read with section 106(2A), cancel the registration of Democratic Municipal and Allied Workers Union of South Africa (DEMAWUSA) (LR 2/6/2/2420) with effect from 30 January 2020

The registration of the trade union is cancelled due to the following reasons:

- The trade union failed to comply with sections 99 and 100 of the Act
- The Union failed to comply with Guidelines for balloting regarding members having a secret ballot before embarking on a strike action.

The name of the Organisation has been removed from the Register of Trade Unions.
