- Marine Pollution (Intervention) Act, 1987 (Act No. 64 of 1987);
- Marine Pollution (Control and Civil Liability) Act (previous title: Prevention and Combating of Pollution of the Sea by Oil Act), 1981 (Act No.6 of 1981);
- Merchant Shipping (Civil Liability Convention) Act, 2013 (Act No. 24 of 2013);
- Merchant Shipping (International Oil Pollution Compensation Fund) Administration Act, 2013 (Act No 35 of 2013); and
- Draft Marine Oil Pollution (Preparedness, Response and Co-Operation) Bill, 2021
