WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATIONS FOR THE TRANSFER OF INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE LICENCE AND INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK SERVICE LICENCE FROM TWIN PEAK TECHNOLOGIES CC TO ABT TELECOMS (PTY) LTD

- The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received a letter from Twin Peak Technologies CC for the withdrawal of its transfer applications for Individual Electronic Communications Service (I-ECS) licence and Individual Electronic Communications Network Service (I-ECNS) licence to ABT Telecoms (Pty)
 Ltd.
- 2. The applications were submitted in terms of Regulation 11 (Form G) of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences, 2010 published in *Government Gazette* No. 33293 of 14 June 2010 as amended by the Amendment Individual Processes and Procedures Regulations 2015 published in Government Gazette No.39871 ("Processes and Procedures Regulations") of 30 March 2016, read with sections 13(1), (2) and (6) of the Electronic Communications Act No.36 of 2005, as amended ("the ECA").
- 3. On 22 January 2021, the Authority published a notice in *Government Gazette* No. 44093 inviting written representations to the transfer applications. The Authority received written representations from interested parties objecting to the Authority's consideration of the Applications.

- 4. On 19 June 2021, the Authority received a letter from Twin Peak Technologies CC, requesting the Authority to withdraw the transfer applications.
- 5. Based on the withdrawal notice above, the notice of 22 January 2021 is similarly withdrawn.
