

# ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS ACT, 2005 (ACT NO. 36 OF 2005)

APPLICATIONS FOR THE TRANSFER OF OWNERSHIP OF THE INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS SERVICE ("I-ECS") AND INDIVIDUAL ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATIONS NETWORK SERVICE ("I-ECNS") LICENCES FROM EPILITE 102 CC TO KYRASCENE (PTY) LTD

- The Independent Communications Authority of South Africa ("the Authority") hereby gives notice that it has received applications from Epilite 102 CC for the transfer of ownership of its Individual Electronic Communications Service ("I-ECS") and Individual Electronic Communications Network Service ("I-ECNS") licences.
- 2. The applications were submitted in terms of Regulation 11 of the Processes and Procedures Regulations for Individual Licences, 2010, published in Government Gazette No 33293 of 14 June 2010, as amended by the Amendment Individual Processes and Procedures Regulations 2015, published in Government Gazette No 39871 of 30 March 2016 ("Processes and Procedures Regulations"), read with section 13 of the Electronic Communications Act No 36 of 2005, as amended ("the ECA").
- 3. In terms of section 13(6), read with section 9(2), of the ECA, the Authority is required to publish a notice in the Government Gazette inviting interested parties to submit written representations on the transfer applications.

- 4. The transfer applications seek approval from the Authority to transfer the I-ECS and I-ECNS licences from Epilite 102 CC ("the Applicant") to Kyrascene (Pty) Ltd ("the Transferee"), and will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:
  - a. promotion of competition in the ICT sector;
  - b. interests of consumers; and
  - c. equity ownership by Historically Disadvantaged Persons ("HDPs").
- 5. The Applicant submits that 100% of the Transferee's equity shareholding is held by HDPs.
- 6. The applications, relevant schedule and any representations received pursuant to this notice will be made available and open for inspection by any interested party in the Authority's library, during the Authority's office hours.
- 7. Interested parties are invited to lodge written representations to the applications within fourteen (14) working days from the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette. The Authority will make the applications received available for public review on its website: <u>www.icasa.org.za</u>.
- Any person who makes written representations must indicate whether they require an opportunity to make oral representations in the event that the Authority decides to hold public hearings.
- All written representations, responses, and other correspondence in terms of this notice must be directed to Licensing Department, at Block B, 350 Witch – Hazel Avenue, Eco Point Office Park, Eco Park, Centurion **OR** Private Bag X10, Highveld Park, 0169 **OR** by e-mail: <u>Licensing@icasa.org.za</u>.
- 10. Any person/s who lodge representations in terms of this notice, must also furnish proof that a copy of the representation has been delivered by hand to Mr Louis Barend Yssel at Epilite 102 CC, located at 52 Old Kent Road, Midstream Estate, 1692 **OR** delivered by e-mail to louis@dfacto.one.

- 11. The Applicant has the right to respond in writing to the written representations made by any interested person/s on the transfer application. The written responses must be lodged with the Authority within twenty-eight (28) working days from the date of publication of this notice in the Government Gazette.
- 12. The Applicant must, at the time of lodging the written response, furnish proof to the Authority's satisfaction that it has delivered a copy of the response by hand, **OR** by e-mail to the relevant person/s having made the written representations.
