**DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT****GENERAL NOTICE 2054 OF 2023****INVITATION FOR NOMINATION AND APPLICATION TO SERVE AS A MEMBER OF THE INTERNATIONAL AIR SERVICES COUNCIL (IASC)**

The Minister of Transport hereby calls for the appointment and nomination for a person to serve as a member of the International Air Services Council (IASC). The International Air Services Council ("Council") is a statutory body established in terms of Sections 3 of the International Air Services Act, 1993 (Act No 60 of 1993). The Council members are responsible for amongst other things, adjudicating applications for International air service licenses, and adjudicating complaints of non-compliance with the Acts.

The Minister of Transport intends to appoint a member to serve in the IASC. The applicant or nominated person to serve in the IASC shall be a person who, in the opinion of the Minister, on account of their training or experience have special knowledge in finance.

The International Air Service Council was appointed for a period of three (03) years, effective from 01 April 2022 until 31 March 2025. The potential candidate will serve for the remainder of the Council's tenure, ending on 31 March 2025. Members are required to meet at least once a month during normal working hours between 8:00 and 16:00. The Remuneration of the Council Members is in accordance with the applicable National Treasury Regulations.

Nominations must contain the full names and address of the person making the nomination and a signed acceptance of the nomination by the nominee.
