

TRANSFER OF THE MADIBA HOUSE AS AN IMMOVABLE ASSET OF THE IZIKO MUSEUMS OF SOUTH AFRICA, IN TERMS OF SECTION 9 (2) and (3) OF THE DECLARED CULTURAL INSTITUTIONS ACT 119 OF 2001.

I, Ncediso Goodenough Kodwa, Minister of Sport, Arts and Culture by the powers vested in me, hereby approve the transfer of the "Madiba House" described as Watervliet, portion 2 of farm 942 located at the Drakenstein Correctional Services as part of the Iziko Museums of South Africa in terms of Section 9 (2) and (3) of the Declared Cultural Institutions Act 119 of 1998. The effective date of the declaration shall be the date of signature as the Minister of Sport, Arts and Culture hereto attached. The Madiba House, and its associated heritage objects are a National Heritage Site, declared on 15 July 2009, in terms of the National Heritage Resources Act 25 of 1999.
